PLATINUM WING AWARDS

COMPETITION RULES

From **January 1st each year**, the **“Platinum Wing Awards”** Competition will be run by the Show Committee of the BSNSW and will be based on a points system for all exhibitors who show at approved events – all status exhibitors are eligible to compete.

In expanding the Competition, the Society will continue, in addition to the Overall points tally, a separate point score Competition for each National Variety plus an AOSV class will be run. *(The AOSV Class points will only apply where a “BEST OF” winners from those Classes has been adjudicated).*

THE POINTS ALLOCATION

- ❖ For Each Variety Award at the Show where all Sections compete for the Major Variety Awards, the winner will receive one point. **(with the exception of the BSNSW Annual Show, where double points are to be allocated)**
- ❖ Where a Branch has Major Variety Awards allocated for Young and Old, both winners will accumulate a point.
- ❖ Where a Variety point score tally results in multiple exhibitors with equal points, then **NO** Certificate will be awarded for that Variety.

MAJOR PRIZE WINNERS

A Sponsor(s) will provide a prize jointly or individually for the Exhibitor/s who from **January 1st each year to December 31st of that year**, accumulate the maximum number of points. In the event of a tie, the prize will be split.

The BSNSW Show Committee will present the Major Prize Winner and the individual Variety Diploma Winners with their Awards at the first BSNSW major event in the following year.

The Major Prize Winner will be photographed and featured in “Budgerigar” magazine and on the Society’s Web site.

BRANCHES WISHING TO PARTICIPATE

The decision on which awards qualify will be decided on production of the rough show schedule, to the Show Manager BSNSW who will make a determination, before printing, to enable Branches to advertise and promote the Competition as an encouragement to exhibit.

Branches are encouraged to include the advice on their schedules -
