Between 8.00am and 9.00am on morning of the show, or by email to the Show Secretary (& President) any time up to mid-day on Saturday the 27<sup>th</sup> March 2010. (Email address robertpitt47@optusnet.com.au).

**Judging** will commence at approximately 10.00 a.m.

## NOTES:

Birds to be exhibited in standard show cages, complete with drinker and with approved budgerigar seed mix on the floor of the cage. Plain white paper or plastic may be placed on the bottom of the show cages.

All entries for Very Young Bird classes must be rung with a closed 2010 ring. Both broken and unbroken capped birds are acceptable.

All entries for Young Bird classes must be rung with closed 2009 rings.

All entries for Old Birds must be rung with either closed 2008 rings or closed rings issued prior to 2008.

All entries must have been bred in the aviary of the exhibitor and rung with a closed ring issued to that exhibitor.

Novice and Intermediate classes are for exhibitors graded as such under the **Pied Society** show rules\* or graded as Novice or Intermediate the BS NSW.

\* The PBS Exhibitors may enter birds in the Novice classes provided they have been breeding or exhibiting budgerigars for less than three years. Exhibitors may enter birds in the Intermediate classes provided they have been breeding or exhibiting budgerigars for less than six years.

Exhibitors that are not graded by the PBS or the BS NSW should enter their birds in the Open classes.
