

Delegate Report



HEAVY FLECKING HEAVY FLECKING

At the recent ANBC meeting the subject of flecking was discussed and photos have been sent out with the ANBC minutes. The two birds above are classed as heavy flecked and judges will be advised to penalise these birds very heavily to the extent of disqualification.

This is said to commence in January 2019

The two below are noted as lightly flecked and will also receive penalties and within a few years will be called heavy flecked as well. The aim is to achieve a clear headed bird as per the ANBC Standard which denotes flecking as a fault requiring penalties. We will shortly have an article put together regarding flecking, breeding and judging, this will be sent out to all Branches & Associations for distribution.
