RULES & CONDITIONS OF THE AUCTION

1. Prospective buyers will be required to Register as they enter the auction room. The Registration Form will require your name, postal address, phone number and signature and identification. Each person will then be given a bidder's number. If you purchase any of the lots, you will be required to give the bidder's number to the auctioneer, to enable the auctioneer's clerk to prepare your Receipt for payment.
2. Each lot will be sold to the highest bidder. Each bidder must ensure that their bid is correctly noted by the Auctioneer. It is preferable for bids to be called out and that the bidder raises their bidder's number to ensure the Auctioneer is able to see the bid. Do not rely on a nod of the head to attract the Auctioneer's attention to your bid. In the event of a disputed bid, the procedure will be in accordance with the condition 1 of the Auction Terms of Sale. Birds which are "passed in" will be available for sale at the end of the Auction.
3. Payment for each lot purchased may be Cash, EFTPOS, Debit Card, Visa or MasterCard. **Personal cheques will not be accepted.** Visa and MasterCard attract a 0.99% surcharge.
4. Successful buyers will be required to take their purchases with them at the end of the day, after payment has been made and their Receipt collected. Proof of payment will be required to enable you to collect your birds. You are to take your carry boxes or cages together with the Receipt to the Collection Clerk to enable you to collect your birds. The Clerk will collect your purchase and the cage will be produced in front of you. Birds must be removed by you and transfer them to your own caging. The birds will not be handled by the vendor, the auctioneer, or any member of staff. It is the responsibility of the purchaser to handle their own purchased birds when they are collected.
5. No recording equipment of any type or nature, including mobile phones, judging sticks or cages will be permitted in the auction room or viewing area. Clearly marked cages indicating the owner's name may be placed in the area provided for collection once payment has been made. Viewers **MUST** not interfere with the birds in any way, including judging sticks, pens or any object whatsoever.
6. The seller or organisers have the right to make alterations, at their discretion, to this catalogue by additions or deletions, or substitution of birds, or by combination of any two lots.
7. The seller has the right to bid, and the highest bidder shall be the buyer. In the event of a dispute in relation to a specific lot, the lot will be presented for sale again and the Auctioneer's decision will be final
8. Following the fall of the hammer no party will be permitted to retract their bid.
9. The Auctioneer reserves the right to accept or refuse any bid or bids without having to provide any reason.
10. The buyer may collect their purchase/s at the end of the auction in accordance with Condition 4 above.

11. BSNSW is acting only as an agent in respect of the birds to be auctioned and are not responsible for any faults or defects in any bird offered for auction. Jim Baker, Mark Finnimore and Steve Wackwitz are the sole representatives of the BSNSW and their decisions are binding and final.
12. The buyer should confirm origin, age and condition of any lot to their own satisfaction.
13. If a successful bidder fails to pay for their purchase/s on the date, the seller or his agent has the right to resell the lot in any manner they consider to be appropriate.
14. It is the responsibility of the sellers and buyers to ensure that all lots must be removed at the completion of the sale. The BSNSW will not be responsible for any birds not removed.
15. Scratchings on the day must be advised to the organisers and Auctioneer prior to the commencement of the Auction.
16. The decision of any two (2) of the BSNSW representatives, Jim Baker, Mark Finnimore and Steve Wackwitz, will be binding and final.
17. The minimum charge to vendors will be \$5 per lot as Entry Fee. Should a bird be scratched and not replaced, then the \$5.00 fee will remain. Should a bird sell for less than \$50.00 then a \$5.00 fee will apply. A commission of 10% is payable to the BSNSW for all birds sold.
18. The seller's acceptance of these conditions is confirmed by the entry of their birds into this Auction.
