The Standard

Mask and Spots:

Mask to be clear, wide and deep, (not cleft) extending beyond large cheek patches containing six large, round evenly spaced black spots. Each outer spot is partially covered by the base of the cheek patches.

Ground Colour:

Must extend over the back of the head into the mantle. Dark grey grizzled suffusion must appear in the ground colour on back of head and mantle.

General Body Colour:

Back, rump, breast, flanks and underparts to be a solid and even shade throughout.

Markings:

On cheeks, back of head, neck and mantle -- minimal. Wing markings, grey in the wing coverts, heavily grizzled with ground colour, merging to a definite black in the secondary and primary flights.

Eyes:

Black with a white iris ring.

Body Colour:

Full intensity

SADDLEBACK GROUP: This includes Yellow Faced Blue Series combined with Saddleback. The Standard for these birds is as for the Saddleback Blue series modified by the applicable Yellow Faced Blue colour with which it is combined.



THE IMPORTANCE OF BALANCED PROTEIN IN THE DIET OF GROWING

PASSERINE AND PSITTACINE BIRDS

Dr Michael Evans Avian Nutritionist Applied Nutrition Pty. Ltd

Young growing birds need significant nourishment in order to develop properly and grow. Altricial birds have the capacity to grow extremely fast and therefore need significant nutrients in adequate amounts and in the correct balance. In captivity, birds are solely reliant on us to provide them with necessary nutrients, particularly protein, amino acids, vitamins and minerals, such as calcium and phosphorus, to grow tissues, skeleton and feathers.

Grains alone cannot provide all the necessary nutrients to support the early growth, feathering and development of young budgerigars. Many of the soft foods available on the market that are being used as supplements, when examined more closely, do not provide the necessary essential nutrients to fill the gaps (deficiencies) in the amino acids coming from grains. It must be remembered that protein is not a single nutrient, but a combination of other building-block components called amino acids. Amino acid composition of protein can vary from ingredient source to ingredient source. For example, the millets are particularly deficient in a number of key essential amino acids, such as lysine and methionine, which if not provided in adequate amounts, can slow growth and development of the young chick and impair feather growth and quality. All grains are also particularly deficient in calcium, and if calcium is not fed to the chick on a daily basis will lead to poor skeletal development and in some severe cases adversely impact on muscle function and blood clotting ability. The choice of soft food has to be on the basis of filling the gaps and correcting the deficiencies in the nutrients coming from the main food sources, i.e. the grains. Otherwise you just might as well feed straight grain.

Applied Nutrition has researched and developed a specific nutrient specification for growing birds from hatch to maturity. For newly hatched chicks, key essential amino acid daily intake is critical to their development and functioning as an adult bird. A comparison of this specification with the nutrient composition of seeds and seed mixes allows us to determine which nutrients are missing and therefore guide us in the correct supplementation. This is the principle approach used in developing our TummyRite range of products.

Applied Nutrition's **Prosperity™** is a complete bird starter food that has been designed and developed to provide a complete compliment of nutrients, including protein, key essential amino acids, vitamins, trace minerals and major mineral such as calcium and phosphorus to support good tissue and feather growth and skeletal development in young birds, particularly during the first 14 days if life. **Prosperity™** is designed to be fed to the breeding birds who in turn feed it to their young chicks. In addition, **Prosperity™** contains **TummyRite™** components, such as herb extracts, yeast functional fibres and enzymes, that aid the bird to develop its own natural immunity to disease challenges and to digest major feed components respectively.

The protein in **Prosperity[™]** is pre-digested, but not a denatured protein, which ensures the protein is more bio-available to the bird, resulting in improved nutrient absorption. The pre-digested process reduces allergenic reactions in birds by removing the allergenic protein components, β -conglycinin, glycinin and lectins that are responsible for these allergenic reactions. **Prosperity[™]** contains lactic acid generated naturally through the fermentation process leading to a product of low pH and excellent palatability. Even birds fed at maintenance (i.e. to maintain good condition), the protein supplied in the diet should be well-balanced. Combining the best of the major ingredients in the diet will rarely result in a completely balanced diet, therefore, small amounts of essential amino acids will need to be provided to completely balance the diet. This makes in difficult when trying to administer nutrients or medicines via the water. Bird keepers need to make a judgement as the best way to do this to ensure adequate nutrient intake.

In conclusion, appropriate balanced nutrient delivery to birds according to their daily requirements is essential if birds are to thrive and develop properly. The appropriate choice of supplement to balance nutrients coming from the seed is the key to a successful feeding programme.

HOW TO SPROUT SEED

My birds get sprouted seed most days each week, year-round. Care must be taken to ensure the seed does not sour of go mouldy, otherwise the birds will become ill. Racehorse Oats are the seeds most frequently soaked and sprouted, but occasionally mung beans, lentils, or mixed seeds are used. The birds relish soaked and sprouted seed, especially when feeding young. Sprouted seed is an excellent way to include soft food and supplements to their diet.

Step One—Soaking Oats

First add cold or lukewarm water until totally covered then soak for 12 hours.





Step Two—Washing Oats

After 12 hours drain and wash the oats. You will be surprised how discoloured the water you soaked them in for the initial 12 hours is. Pour cold water over the oats until they are thoroughly washed, and the water runs clean.

Step Three—Drain Oats

After soaking and washing for 24 hours the oats are transferred to a colander with mesh or small holes the water can drain through. The oats are now rinsed/washed 2-3 times a day, until small white roots start to appear.





Step Four—Sprouting

When small roots start to appear it is time to start feeding to the birds. When introducing to your birds do not feed too many initially but gradually increase the amount. I have several "bowls" going at one time, so we feed oats at various stages of germination... from small roots beginning to show - to sprouts that are 2-3" long.

Step Five—Ways to Increase Protein and Adding the Soaked Seed to Soft Food

If you wish to increase protein intake you can always sprinkle or mix in egg food or other supplements. I mix my own "soft food" consisting of dried breadcrumbs, powdered egg, non-medicated chick starter crumbs, gamebird grower crumbs, powdered kelp, EMP egg food, Hormova, and a commercial nestling food.

The soaked seed is thoroughly rinsed and drained then the soft food is added, mixed in, and allowed to sit for 5-10 minutes so the crumbles absorb any moisture and soften.





To supply additional animal protein freeze-dried mealworms are soaked in warm water for several minutes to plump them up, then added to the mix. Mealworms are a great natural animal protein source. 50% Protein & 25% Fat... Once they get the taste the budgies love them and will pick them out of the feed before they touch anything else.




Ready for the feeding frenzy. Vegetables, Sprouted Oats & Mealworms are mixed and fed to breeding cages and the flights.

This is fed in the morning and again late afternoon during the breeding season. Any leftovers are removed before lights out.
