A "classified ads" section

(may be later down the track) a "Members' Section" s where we could place things like the emagazine (instead of emailing it to everyone)

Response – "As long as there were not tons of ads. Were you thinking of a page where members cold add their own ad or submit them to me to post?"

Not knowing anything about web sites could you please tell me if

The present site has the space/capacity for additional features?

Response – "Yes it does. I would need to check how much space remains available. My Impression is that there is space for extras."

The site can be set up for members to post their questions/answers direct to a forum?

Response – "Yes, as above (re spammers) but I would not be involved in running it."

It would be easier (or necessary) to have a whole new site built in order to incorporate the above in with most of the existing information?

Response – "Not necessary. The question is there the man-power to run it"

Looking at the above responses it would seem that we cannot consider any features that allow direct imput from members/public. These types of pages could only be added if a member (or members) volunteered to post items. Are you willing to take on such a task?

As we are also giving consideration to building a completely new website we would love to hear from anyone that has this capability. (We have had one member express interest but would like to hear from as many as possible)

JEFF YOUNIE

On April 26, 2014, the bird fancy lost another enthusiastic member and willing worker when Jeff Younie passed away. I first met Jeff in the early 1970's when he was a member of the Camden-Campbelltown Cage Bird Society and as we were both budgerigar fanciers it was not long before we with 3 others travelled to Yagoona to the then Padstow Branch of the BSA.

In 1974 we formed the Macarthur Branch of the BSA. Jeff during the first 20 years of Macarthur was always an office bearer, from Show Secretary, Show Manager and many other positions, he was always a reliable member of the work force behind Macarthur Branch.

In 1989 he received a merit award from the BSA for outstanding service and then in 1992 he received Life Membership of Macarthur Branch.

Jeff was also a man of principle and when the society decided to impose rules on judges, re showing birds, he felt a judge should be gauged on his ability to judge and not on his ability to buy birds so he along with others resigned from the judges panel. The society not only lost a judge but lost a very willing worker. Jeff then went back to his love of finches, in particular Zebra Finches and became recognised as a willing worker and a reliable member of this part of the fancy. To me Jeff was always someone I could rely on, when I was Chief Steward for the BSNSW he was always a sectional Steward and then as Show Manager of the Zebra Finch Society, Jeff was always there to help put up and mark off the staging and any other job that fell our way. To say I miss you mate is a gross understatement, I will miss the many conversations as we drove to the meetings together in particular the ones on pairing birds and the many times we swapped birds.

Rest in peace old mate, you will never be forgotten.

N.S.W. TEAM CARERS' REPORT - 2014

The Dural Sports Centre was once again this year's venue for the State Team Challenge Competition and NSW Selection, for entry into the 40th ANBC Championship Show to be held in South Australia on the weekend of 21st and 22nd June, 2014. In a trend which seems to be coming all too familiar, entries were way down in a lot of the classes, with a total of only 16 teams participating on the day.

The big surprise of the day was the way in which The Pied Society jumped away in the point score and left the rest of us well behind, in their wake. Congratulations must go to the Pied Society team organisers and all exhibitors in that team. The Pied Society won the day with 717 points, followed by Mid State on 663, then Northern NSW on 648. Next was Newcastle, The Hills and New England.

The days when the average breeder looked forward to showing their birds for their State at the National appear to be slipping away at a fast rate of knots. Some outstanding birds were entered on the day, but sadly, the numbers and quality fell away very fast in some classes.

One thing which is very important at the National Show is trying to get both birds up into the "top end" of the results, to gain maximum points.

With help from the usual few, the birds were caged up in preparation for the trip to the holding cages, where they were to be held prior to flying to Adelaide the following weekend. A close inspection first thing on Sunday morning revealed that a number of the birds had not been sprayed enough prior to the STCC and there was also a few that appeared to have been shown in the weeks leading up to it.

If breeders really want to do well at the National Show, they would be far better advised to not show their birds for at least the 6 weeks leading up to it. A bird which has been prepared, say 4 weeks prior, does not always respond well to be prepared again so soon. The weather was very kind to us, as we had bright sunshine every day, which made it easier to spray water onto the team at least twice every day; some enjoyed it, some had no idea what it was. One bird off colour for a couple of days was our only problem this year. Almost all the team responded well to the preparation procedures which we use. Once again, we were lucky not to have to substitute any of the birds which had been selected to take part. No lost tails, just a couple of missing flights.

The team spent minimum time in the Airline freight boxes, as they travelled in wire cages to the airport, which showed on their arrival at the venue. There had only been one compartment where a bit of fighting had occurred. The team arrived at the venue at about 4pm on Thursday afternoon to be greeted by Doug Lange and his security team. Arriving on the Thursday has just about become the norm these days, so as to give the birds a full day on the Friday to rest and recuperate after the flight.

The venue was The Grand Chancellor Hotel on Hindley in the centre of Adelaide. It would be hard to heap too much credit on the Committee of the Budgerigar Council of South Australia. The venue was excellent in almost every way. The only thing which we could not procure at the venue was lunch, but that was available across the road at

the PUB. \$15.00 for lunch and a pint of whatever you wanted to drink; even NSW Beer. How good is that!

The accomodation was where all events took place over the weekend and the holding room for the teams was no more than 5 metres from the Judging Hall itself. This was perfect for those of us who have no other life, except birds for the weekend. A Vet was on hand all weekend, which was reassuring for those of us responsible for our respective State Teams.

Day 1

The Hens class was the first to be benched, then odd numbered classes to follow. 6.30 am was entry into the holding room to start caging the birds up by 8 am pick up. We haven't been able to get the lights on early enough prior to the carers entering the holding rooms as yet, but hopefully, this will be a priority next year. Judges' comments and results were as follows:-

<u>Class – Hens</u> - Both Hens showed what they had from the start, with the Grey Spangle defying the Judges to pick anyone but her. She did not move from the perch. Our second hen eventually moved up the row after they saw her. Both excellent hens, a real credit to Mark Hawke - 1st & 4th.

<u>Class 1 - Normal Green</u> - The Dark Green Cock sat well, while sadly, the Light Green did not stop running all day. The bird in 3^{rd} place was extremely lucky on the day. Judges did comment on the length of the flights on some of the birds in the class, 3^{rd} & 6^{th} .

<u>Class 3 - Normal Blue</u> - first bird showed his attributes while the second bird was moved to last place immediately. The Judge said his long flights were not acceptable these days. 6^{th} & 14^{th} .

<u>Class 5 - Normal Grey</u> - The comment from the Judges was that after the 4^{th} place bird, the birds were not strong enough to be competitive in the class, 5^{th} & 6^{th} .

<u>Class 7 - Australian Golden Face</u> - Our first bird was moved to the front quickly and the comment was that they were looking for Double Factor birds in this class. For a bird which came out of the breeding cabinet the night before the STCC, the bird did well on the day.

1st & 8th.

<u>Class 9 - Dilute ASC</u> - Judges said our first bird had good colour which moved it up. The second bird was nice, but held it's leg at a funny angle at times, 3rd & 6th.

<u>Class 11 - Red Eved Albino</u> - Lovely modern Hen with the qualities that they were looking for. The bird in third was unlucky to meet two better birds on the day, 1st & 3rd.

<u>Class 13 - Greywing ASC</u> - Beautiful colour in the Blue bird and our Grey Green was just behind it, $4^{th} \& 5^{th}$.

<u>Class 15 - Spangle Double Factor ASC</u> - Exceptionally strong bird with lovely feather and did not move off the perch all day. Second bird had a bit of a problem with a feather in it's eye on the day, 1st & 8th.

- <u>Class 19 Lacewing ASC, ASV</u> Winning Hen sat very well on the day and had a nice top end and feather, which put her in front of the next cock bird. Our second bird did not want to be there, 1st & 9th.
- <u>Class 21 Spangle ASC</u> Our first bird was nice, but a bit loose in the wings on the day. The second bird had been off colour and in the hospital cage for 24 hours the previous day. Both were a bit short behind the perch, 3rd & 7th.
- <u>Class 23 Dominant Pied ASC, ASV</u> Our first placed bird stood well off the perch, which eventually led to it being placed in front of the Grey bird from S.A. Had our Light Green stopped turning circles on the cage front it would have won the class easily. Not to be. 1^{sr} & 3rd.
- <u>Class 25 Crest ASC, ASV</u> Both birds staged reasonably well, although had the Dark Green bird been a bit steadier earlier on, it probably could have gone on to win, 2nd & 4th.

After the first day, we were leading by 10 points, which was a bit of a buzz. But after looking at what the Mexicans had to come the next day, we weren't all that confident at all.

Dav 2 - Even numbered classes:

- Class 2 Normal Grey Green The first three birds were outstanding on the day. The second placed bird was Super & extremely unlucky. Our birds did well to end up 4th & 7th.
- <u>Class 4 Normal Violet</u> First couple of birds were good, but after that they were down on size and shape, and were too old fashioned, 7th & 8th.
- <u>Class 6 Yellow Faced Blue</u> Our Grey bird went straight to the front and was never headed. Sadly our second bird dropped it's tail on Saturday afternoon and was disqualified from the event, even though it's tail feather did appear in the cage on Sunday. Worth a try??? 1st & disqualified.
- <u>Class 8 Black Eyed Self Colour ASC</u> Great class, winning bird best they had seen. Second and third were good variety birds, but our second bird had suffusion problems, 4th & 5th.
- <u>Class 10- Red Eyed Lutino</u> Our second bird eventually moved up from ninth place to finish fifth. Both birds staged well on the day. Colour is very important in this class, 4th & 5th.
- <u>Class 12 Clearwing ASC</u> First 2 birds in this class were stand-outs, and the wing clarity of our fourth placed bird was commented on, 4th & 10th.
- <u>Class 14 Cinnamonwing ASC</u> Our first placed bird did not put a foot wrong all day. Right from the start, it didn't move from the perch, even when prodded by the Judges. Our second bird did not stage well at all, but it was still good enough to be placed third, 1st & 3rd.
- <u>Class 16 Opaline ASC</u> First 5 were all excellent strong birds; after that they tapered off rather quickly, 9th & 11th.

<u>Class 18 - Clearbody ASC, ASV</u> - Strong class of birds at the top end. First placed bird was a good variety, with nice spots. Enough type to get him over the line. Our second bird had a good mask, but no width of skull, which pulled it back a couple of places, 1st & 6th. <u>Class 20 - Fallow ASC, ASV</u> - our first bird went straight into second spot. Nothing was going to beat the winner (a Yellow Face from Victoria) on the day. First six birds were all good, 2nd & 9th.

<u>Class 22 - Spangle ASC, AOSV</u> - Judges' comment was that there was no stand-out bird at all in this class. The first placed bird staged reasonably well and the first 4 were the strongest; after that they fell away. Our second bird did not get off the floor at all, 5th & 13th.

<u>Class 24 - Recessive Pied ASC, ASV</u> - First 6 birds were all good birds. All up it was a pretty reasonable class of birds, $5^{th} & 6^{th}$.

<u>Class 26 - Dark Eyed Clear -</u> Comments were that they were all in good feather and it is to be hoped that they will improve in type and shape in the years to come, 2nd & 5th.

The Judges this year were: Stephen Mow, Victoria, Kevin O'Callaghan, North Queensland,

Nigel Tonkin, South Australia and Linda Patten, New Zealand.

We ended up with a total of Nine Logies for the weekend, which was "ONE" less than those bloody Mexicans, who managed to do us over once again this year. The final point score was as follows-: Victoria 539, New South Wales 502, South Australia 438, South Queensland 368,

Western Australia 362, Tasmania 269, North & Central Queensland 347.

A big "Thank You" to Bruce Bradford, Maureen Bourne, James Matthews and all their respective helpers who put untold hours into the preparations for this event. I'm sure that we lose a small forest every year, just to supply the amount of necessary paperwork to take part.

As a final footnote, we, the Carers, feel that some type of directive has to be given by those at the Pointy End of our Society, to all exhibitors in NSW, as to whether or not our birds are to be benched as is, or are they to be prepared by the owners prior to the show in Sydney. It would appear to us, at present, that less work is being done on the birds each year.





Letter to the Editor:

Blackeye Self Colours / Dilutes / Yellowface Blues

For some time I have been concerned with some of the problems with classifying Budgerigars.

- 1. Blackeye Self colour
- 2. Dilutes
- 3. The placing of Yellowface Blue

In regard to the Blackeye Self colour it is important to understand the class is for Blackeyed Self <u>not</u> Greywings. The placing of grey yellow in the Self class will in time be the demise of the Self colour. This has occurred despite experience with the greygreen and grey almost wiping out the green and blue classes. I would suggest if people require to exhibit grey yellows a class be establish for this variety. A class for grey yellow can easily be written by any person familiar with Self coloureds.

In regard to the Dilutes, this is an unfortunate term that has crept into our terms as most birds are dilute that are not normals. The truth is, these birds are generally the actual greywing mutation, I refer you to 'Cult of the Budgerigar' (sixth edition) by W. Watmough; Breeding Budgerigars by Dr. M.M. Vriends and Cessa Feyeraband.

I also have in my possession, Australia Cage Bird magazines with a depth articles on the greywing mutation when it was being worked on by a Mr. Browne in the 1930s. He describes the bird as almost 50% body colour with birds in the hands of poor breeders being even less than 50%. He also describes how these birds n be mated to clearwings to lift the body colour at the risk of darkening the wing colour. I suggest we have a class for 50% coloured greywings or forget them instead of trying to fit them into existing classes.

In regard to the placement of the yellow face blue in every class, this was done by stealth. The alteration to the Yellowface in the Matrix should have been put to the member bodies for approval before being finalised. As a member of your colour and Standards Committee, I can assure you it was simply given to us as a completed decision. It is worth remembering this is in reality only for the ANBC show and if the majority of the fanciers in NSW do not agree with this decision, we should revert to the old system of Yellowface placement.

Further, our delegates to the council should be instructed to advise ANBC of this decision. If we are alone on this point (I doubt we are) we only have to put Yellowface blue in other classes once a year.

Suggested Standard for Grey Yellow:

Mask To be clear wide and deep beyond two large cheek patches.

General Body Colour Optimum to be even shade throughout of a mustard yellow colour

poor specimens will be greenish yellow.

Markings The melanin sites to be visible and devoid of dark colouring ending

to be, as per the body colour.

Primary Flights To be lighter than the body colour but showing signs of black.

Feathering to be showing from black colouring to being black. The

quill should show signs of black but not compulsory.

Cheek Patch As Blackeye self only darker.


