All Exhibits are to have been bred in the aviaries of the exhibitor and YOUNG BIRDS are to be rung with a Blue 2023 closed ring.

All birds must be rung with an approved closed ring.

Only approved Budgerigar Mix to be used in Show Boxes. (No plain Panicum or millet sprays).

Rings cards may be required for the rings of major winners to be checked.

Restricted status is limited to members who have Novice or Intermediate Grading provided by the Budgerigar Society of NSW, the Budgerigar Council of Victoria or the South Western NSW Budgerigar Society.

Exhibitors who are not current members of BSNSW OR BCV must show in Open young or Any Age)

Exhibitors who have a BCV grading as Champion Exhibitor status are to show in South Western BSNSW show as Platinum status.

The South Western NSW Budgerigar Society Inc. will take all care but will not accept responsibility for any loss or damage to any exhibit or equipment.

Heat clause will come into effect if the temperature for Sunday 10th March 2024 is forecast at 35 degrees or higher on the 7pm ABC TV News on Friday 8th March 2024.


