CELEBRATING 75TH ANNUAL BIRD SHOW

I'd like to go through a part of the clubs history that was put together by our Life Member Don Price.

It was in March 1947 that a group of bird fanciers got together and decided to form a bird club and call it The Wollongong & District Avicultural Society. Their plan was to get the residents of Wollongong and outlying areas together to further their interest in breeding and showing aviary birds. The first bird show was held in June and the club invited several Fish fanciers to display their aquarians with our birds to give the general public a show worth seeing. As with most shows in those days the first show was a two-day show. It proved a reasonable success with good public attendance with between 150 and 200 entries coming from top breeders in Sydney and the local area. It's interesting to see the dress code. Some old photos of the shows around at that time show judges wearing coats and ties, exhibitors wore coats with open neck shirts.

Over the years the Society ran extra shows in conjunction with the Agricultural Societies in the region. One of these, Dapto Agricultural Society continues to invite us back for their annual show. The club held a young bird show for 24 years for members at a different location in the area each year to try and get more exposure for the hobby. The highest number of entries was 1282 in 1976. This demonstrated the strength of the club at that time. This show was abandoned in 1982 as more members started to travel to the big Sydney and country shows. The club has only cancelled two shows in all those years, one in 1981 when the hall was unavailable and the other in 1986, not sure why. This is a great effort by the club and members, not even Covid stopped the club shows going on.

I'd like to mention one of Life Members, Eddy Vormister (a Canary man) who was involved in this club for many years I believe turned. 104 in January this year. Well done Eddy.

We have come a long way since those days, but the principals are the same.

Today it's our 75th Annual Bird Show I'd like on behalf of all my members to welcome you all to one of the most prestigious bird shows on the calendar. A big thankyou to all our Major club sponsors Blue Scope Community Partners & WIN TV Bunnings and many more sponsors. Without these, our show would not be the success it is. Congratulations to Brad and Mary Kerr on becoming our latest life members. These two people have been the back bone of our clubs success and the great shows that we all have enjoyed over the past decade.

To all my committee and helpers, thank you for making today the show piece it is.
