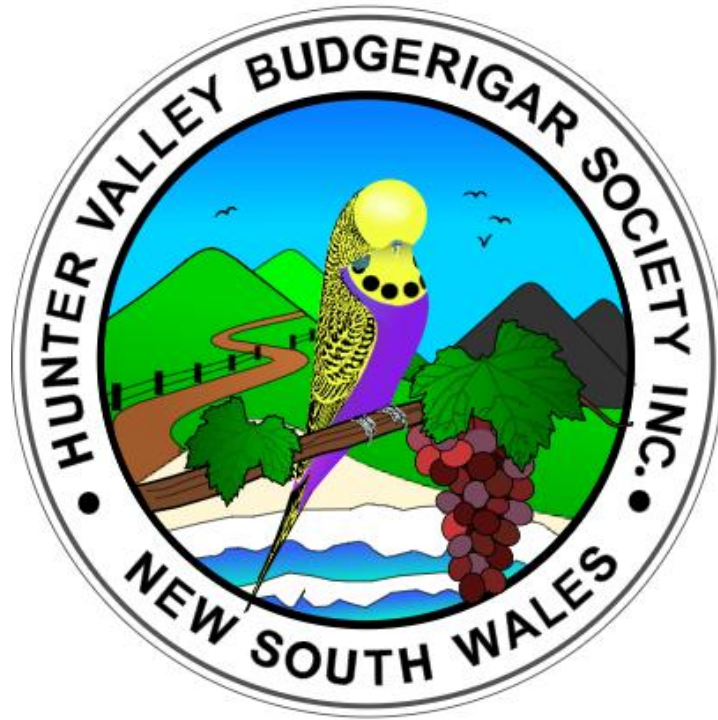

SHOW RULES:

All Birds must be rung with a closed aluminium ring, Birds may carry 1 plastic split ring on opposite leg.

Standard seed mix to be used in all show cages.

Young Birds to carry a 2024 Red ring.

No Unbroken Cap (UBC) Birds to be entered in this Show due to our duty of care for baby birds as determined by the BSNSW Rules.

Birds in dirty show cages will not be judged.

No person other than Judges may use sticks or similar items on the Birds.

No birds are to be removed from the staging during the Show without the permission of the Show Manager.

Only BSNSW approved Show Cages will be accepted with a single drinker fixed between the 4th and 5th bar from the left side. Plastic Show Cage protectors are permitted on the bottom of Show Cages.

Stickers to be placed on the bottom left-hand side of the Show Cage.

Non-Standard NSV / NSC Birds to have a second sticker on right hand side of the Show Cage containing a clear description of the Bird.

Black tape or a drawing pin may be used to secure the door of your Show Cages.

All exhibited birds must have been bred in the Aviary of the Exhibitor.

A maximum of 10 Birds only will be accepted per Exhibitor.

Only 2 birds per standard Show Cage and no more than 10 permitted in large holding wire cages.

All sale Budgies will be sold by the owner,

Food and water must be supplied throughout the day for all Sale Birds.

A sign MUST be attached to each cage stating the Owner's name, mobile number, and the price of the Sale Birds.
