The Show will be conducted under the Rules & Regulations of the South Western NSW Budgerigar Society Inc (SWNSWBS) and the Budgerigar Society of NSW (BSNSW).

All Exhibits are to have been bred in the aviaries of the exhibitor and YOUNG BIRDS are to be rung with a closed RED 2024 ring.

Exhibitors who are not current members of BSNSW must show in Any Age or Open Young.

All Intermediate and Novice Young birds are to be rung with a BSNSW issued ANBC ring.

Ring Cards should be carried as random checks may be carried out.

Heritage birds will be judged in accordance with the ANBC 1962 Standard of Perfection and birds can be any age. Emphasis will be given to condition, body colour intensity and wing markings (or lack thereof).

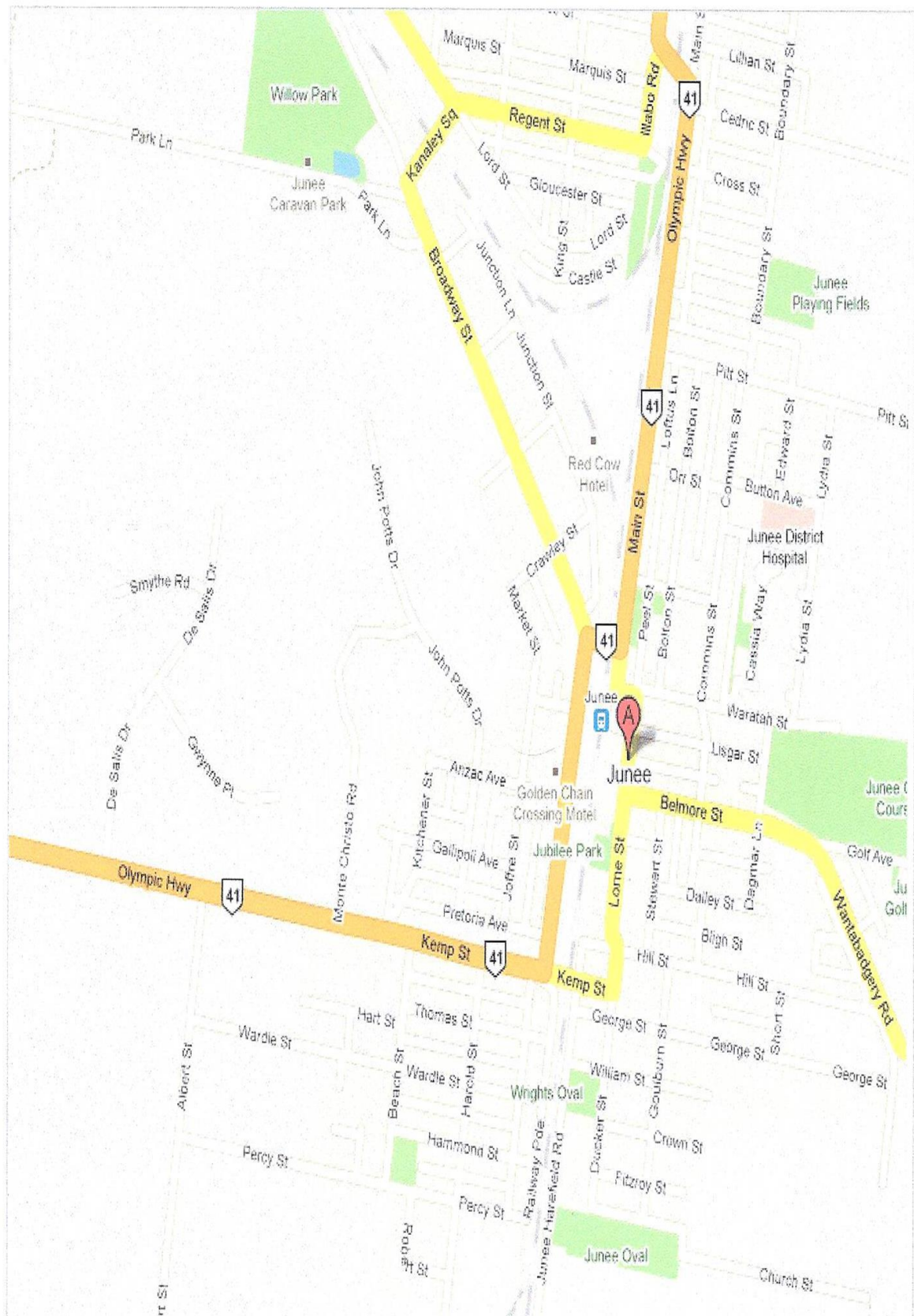
To encourage show entries the AHBA will accept any bird whether it is rung with an enclosed ring or not.
